### TO REACH CAMP CEDAR GLEN

#### TO JULIAN:

- From **San Diego** or **El Centro**: Take I-8 to Hwy 79 North to Main Street in Julian. Continue north on Main until it becomes Farmer Road. Or, take Hwy 67 to Ramona where it merges with Hwy 78. Continue east on Hwy 78 to Julian.
- From **North San Diego County, Los Angeles, or Orange County**: Reach Hwy 78 via I-5 or I-15. Continue on Hwy 78 East to Julian.
- From **Riverside**: Take I-15 to Temecula. Exit Hwy 79 South (Indio exit). Continue on 79 South to Santa Ysabel where it merges with Hwy 78. Turn left at stop sign and proceed to Julian.

#### FROM JULIAN TO CAMP CEDAR GLEN:

- Turn left at stop sign on Main Street (becomes Farmer Road after 2 blocks). Continue for 2 miles north on Farmer Road. Turn right on Wynola Road. After 1 block turn left back onto Farmer Road. Continue north for 3/4 mile. At bottom of hill, turn right onto driveway and continue 1/2 mile to Camp Cedar Glen.

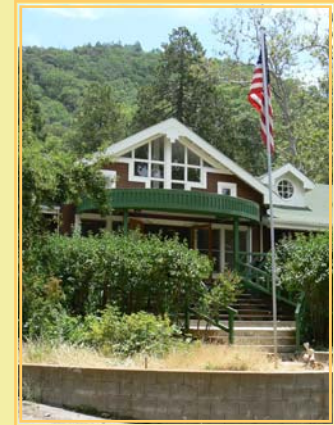
